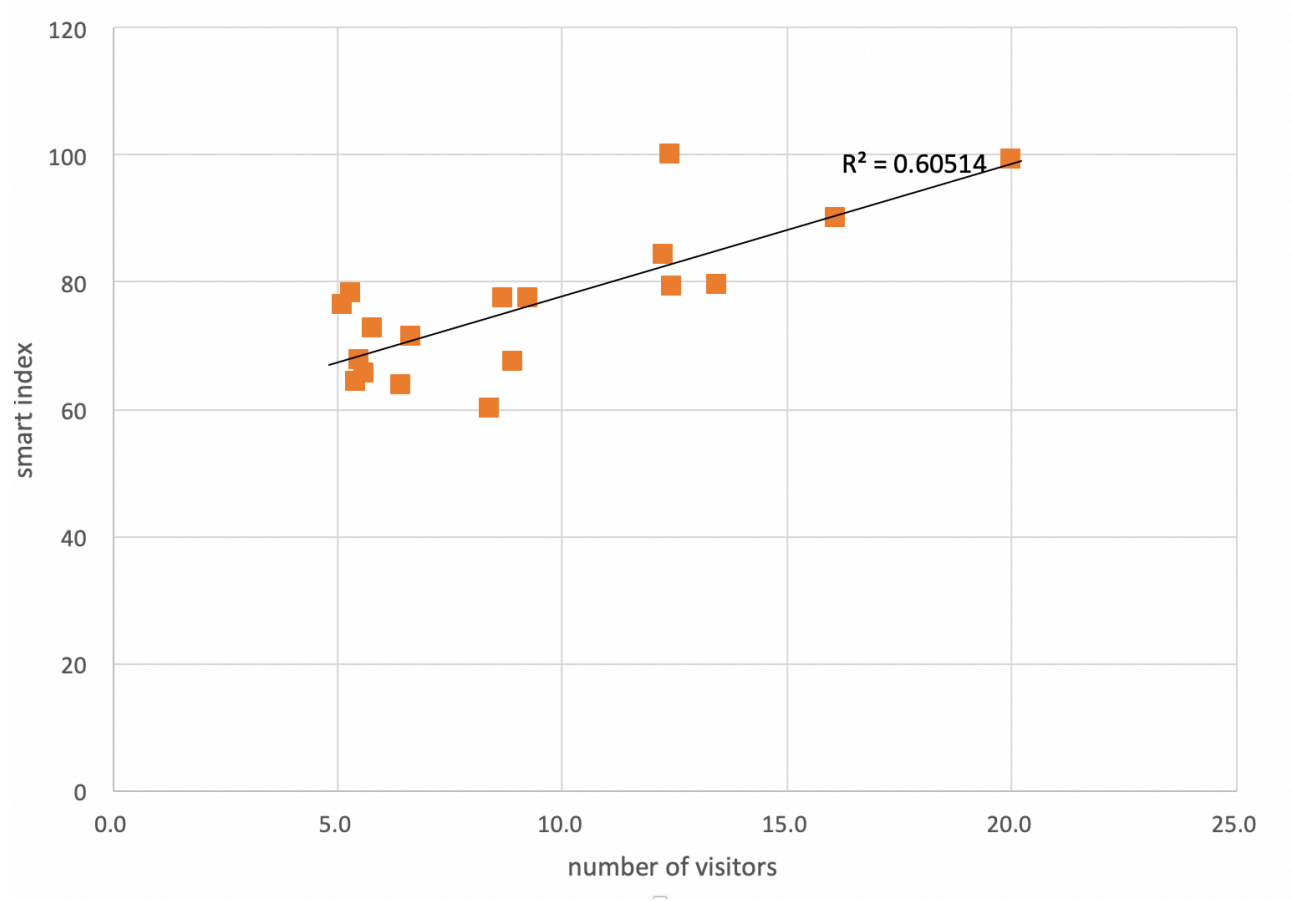

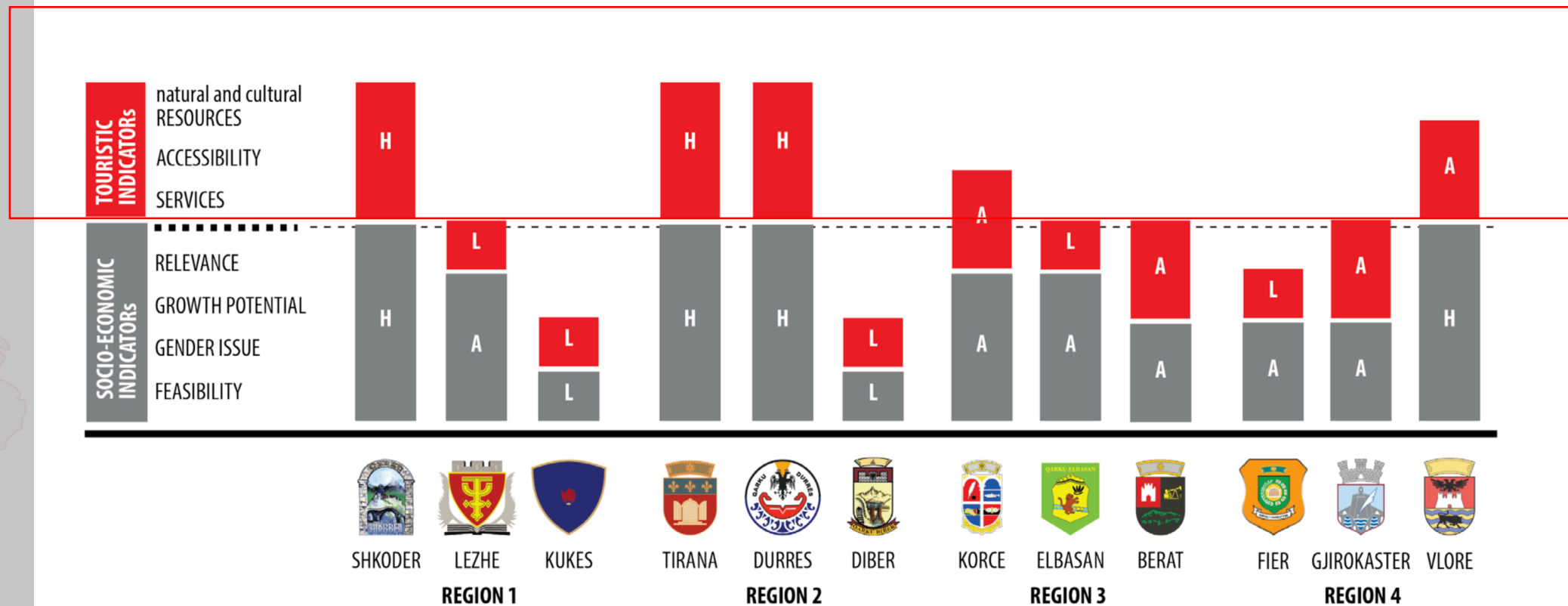
There is a lack of political will (the example of the “*Qark*” (administrative region in Albania) in region-making/strengthening.

To date, we have no successful working model of an administrative or functional region model or intermediary governance level in Albania.



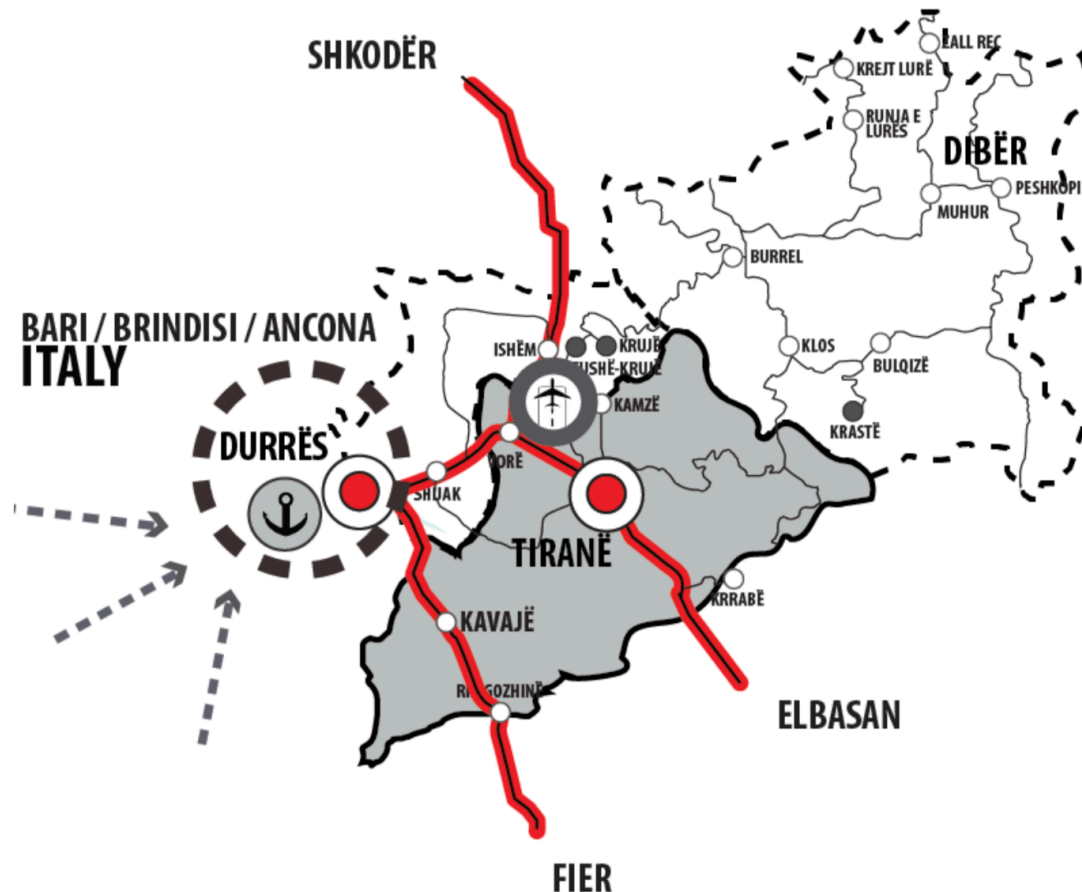
# Touristic Potential of the Regions

Smart tourism can work on a regional level if it enhances the valorisation of a region's specificities , but it cannot replace them.



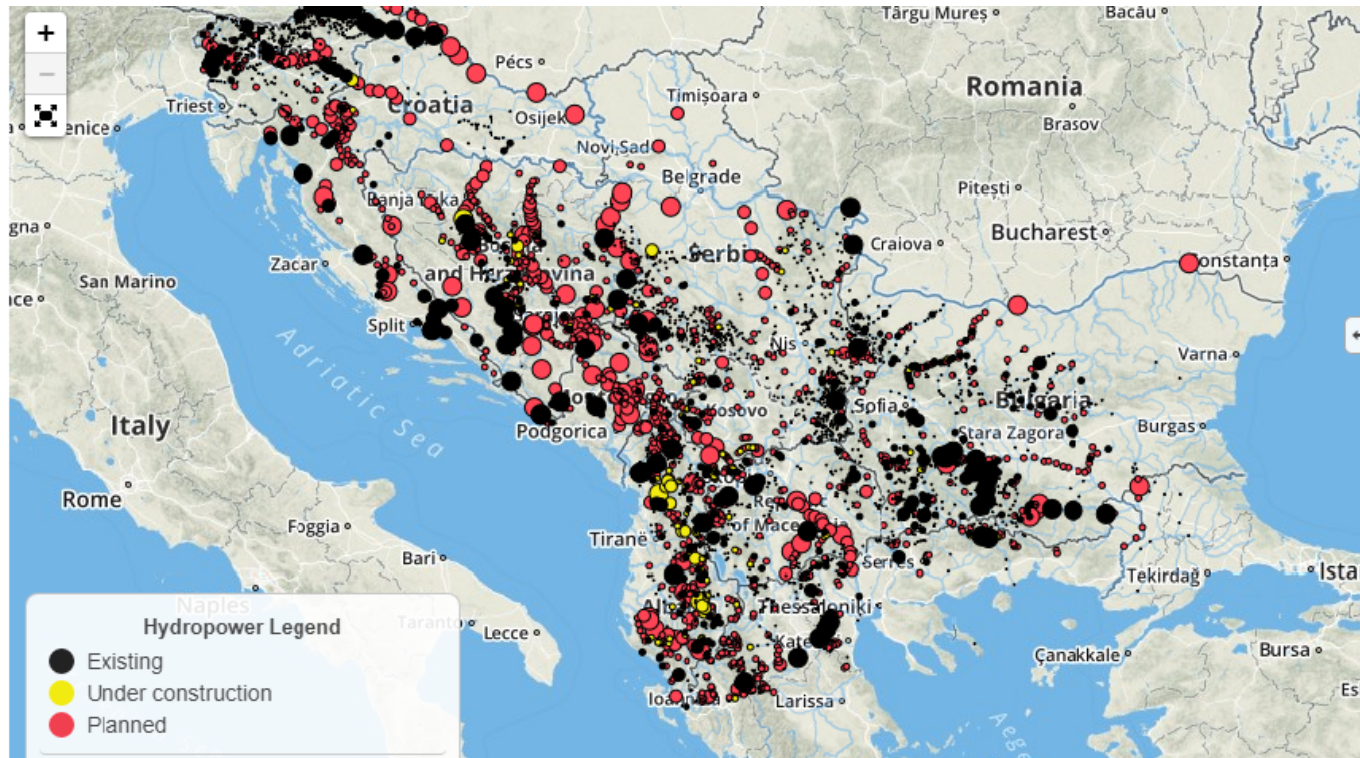
# Cooperation among cities

Overlapping strategies that lack alignment or harmonisation (the example of development priorities vs. energy)

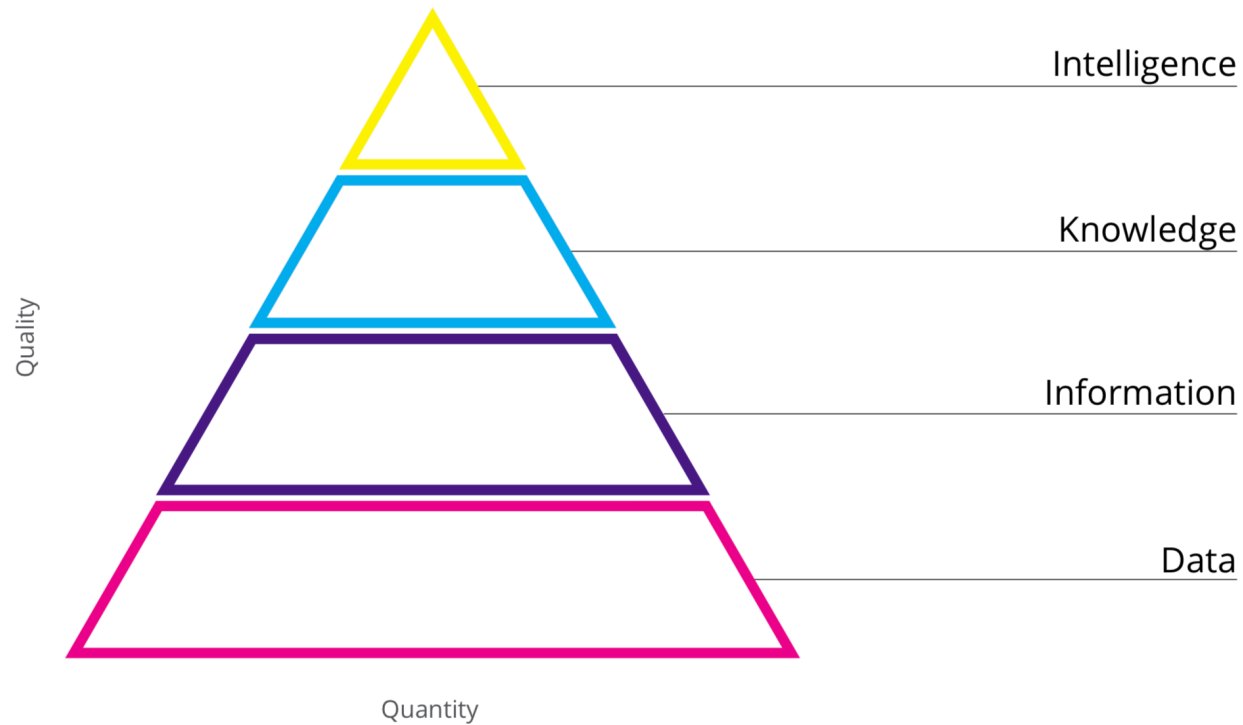
